

2019 WORLD BOWLING TOUR FINALS

KUWAIT

General

1. The World Bowling Tour (WBT) Finals will be held at the Kuwait Bowling Centre, Kuwait on the 7th November 2019.
2. The athletes that will qualify for the finals will be as follows;
 - a. The top 3 male and female athletes from the 2019 World Bowling Tour rankings list after the completion of the 2019 Kuwait Open. If any of these athletes are unable to participate their position will be taken by the next athlete from the rankings list.
 - b. One male and female athlete from each of the 3 Zones (Asian, European and Pan American) as determined by the zone. If any of these athletes are in the top 3 of the World Bowling Tour rankings list their position will be taken by the next athlete from the zone.

Format

3. The World Bowling Tour Finals will be conducted in the following format:

Stage 1

- a. The finals shall be a round robin competition between the 6 qualified athletes.
- b. One game matches will be played. A final match will be played as a position round, making a total of 6 games.
- c. Position numbers for the pre-arranged schedule shall be decided by draw.
- d. Standings shall be based on points won for each match, including the position round.
- e. Athletes shall be awarded 2 points for a win and one point for a tie.
- f. If there is a ties for any of the top three positions a one ball roll-off will be held repeated until the tie is broken.

Step Ladder Finals

- g. Step ladder finals shall be conducted, for the top 3 players after the 6 matches to determine the champion, second and third positions.
- h. Number three shall play number two, one game total pinfall to count.
- i. The winner shall play number one, one game total pinfall to count. The winner of this match will be declared the 2019 World Bowling Tour Champion.
- j. If there is tie in any of the step ladder finals matches a one ball roll off will be held repeated until the tie is broken.

Prize Money

4. Prize money will be awarded to both Men and Women according to the following table (USD).

1 st	\$12,500
2 nd	\$7,500
3 rd	\$5,000
4 th -6 th	\$2,500
